The Proceeds from this event benefit the American Cancer Society Relay for Life. Fire Chief Phil Armentrout answered his last alarm on December 27, 2005, after a 12 year battle with cancer. He started this event in 2005 to benefit the Relay for Life, and his Department carries on that tradition with honor. Due to the success of the 2007 Trap Shoot, the Murrieta Fire Department was able to serve as the presenting sponsor (\$10,000 level) of the 2008 Relay for Life. We know that with your help the event will be an even bigger success this year.

Attached are all the necessary forms and waivers required prior to your participation in this event. Please return the Entry/Liability Release Form and Temecula Valley Gun Club Hold Harmless Agreement for each shooter. 5 – Shooter Teams

We will be shooting 3 rounds of American Trap (75 targets per person at 16 yards, one shot per target). We will be shooting as a team of 5 with a station rotation after every 5th shot.

As this is a team event the final score will be based on the total amount of team hits out of a total of 375 possible. We will be awarding trophies for the top 3 highest team scores.

This is an amateur event!

In the event of a tie for any of the top 3 place a sudden death shoot of will occur, this means that the tied teams will pick their top shooter and the first one to miss at 16 yards moves to the next lower position.

We have attached a copy of the range rules to this packet, the Team Captain or #A shooter needs to cover the rules with their team. Ear and eye protection is mandatory to participate.

No 10 gauges allowed, no steel shot, magnum or hot loads allowed, 12 gauge 11/2 ounce loads are limited to 1290 feet per second and 12 gauge 11/8th ounce loads are limited to 1320 feet per second. Violation of range rules and load restrictions may be cause for disqualification.

If we have an odd number of shooters the day of the event we may arrange for an individual fun shoot with rules to be announced later in the day.

RANGE RULES

ALL SHOOTERS MUST READ AND AGREE TO THESE RULES.

In consideration of being eligible to engage in trapshooting at the **TEMECULA VALLEY GUN CLUB, INC.** shooting range, the following rules are to be adhered to and acknowledged by signing the **Hold Harmless Agreement** therefore holding harmless the persons referred to below. **Read and keep these rules.**

1. The safety of shooters, range personnel and spectators requires self-discipline; this is the duty of all members.
2. All unsafe actions on the range **must** be corrected.
3. Treat all firearms as if they were loaded- **AT ALL TIMES.**
4. Check all firearms before firing.
5. Keep muzzle of firearms under control and pointed in a safe direction- **AT ALL TIMES.**
6. Never use a malfunctioning firearm.
7. Keep actions open on firearms except when on the firing line **AND** ready to fire.
8. Never load more than one round at a time (two rounds for doubles).
9. Upon the command to "**Cease Fire**", immediately unload firearm.
10. Inexperienced shooters are to be accompanied by an experienced shooter (at the discretion of the range officials).
11. All shooters must become thoroughly familiar with TVGC rules, range operations and commands.
12. There will be no alcoholic beverages consumed or present in the shooting area.
13. Prizes for Club Shoots will be determined by the Officers and Board of Directors and subject to change the day of the shoot.
14. Agree to adhere to the Range Master's instructions and follow logical criteria cited by the Range Master, Officers and Board Members.
