

Murrieta and Caltrans Team Up to Improve Interchanges and Overpasses

More than \$90 million has been allocated towards five major interchange/overcrossing projects that are either currently under construction or will begin construction shortly. The list below provides approximate construction beginning and ending dates.

| Project Description | Estimated Start Construction Date | Estimated End Construction Date |

| I-215/Linnel Lane Overpass Construct a four lane overpass over I-215 to connect Linnel Lane from McElwain Road to Meadowlark Lane. | February 2007 | December 2007 |
| I-215/Clinton Keith Road Interchange Remove existing bridge and install a new six lane bridge with northbound and southbound loop ramps. Widen and realign diagonal on-ramps and off-ramps. | August 2007 | November 2008 |
| I-215/Los Alamos Road Interchange Widen existing two lane bridge to six lanes and widen and realign existing on-ramps and off-ramps. | August 2006 | October 2007 |
| I-15/California Oaks Road Interchange Widen California Oaks/Kalmia Road to six through lanes with dual left turn lanes. Realign and widen existing southbound and northbound off-ramps. Construct new loop on-ramps and widen existing bridge to accommodate loops. | September 2008 | March 2010 |
| I-15/Los Alamos Road Overpass Widen existing two lane Los Alamos Road overpass over I-15 to four lanes. | January 2008 | December 2008 |
